

LESSON PLAN 6 – Seed safari

MATERIALS

- Paper bags – one for variety of seed collected.
- Reference books on local plants and/or computer research

ACTIVITY

1. **Introduction:** You are going on safari. But you're not looking for elephants or zebras. You're on a seed safari.
2. Collect as many different types of seeds as possible with your classmates.
3. Put each type in a different bag.
4. Compare appearance and location.
5. Identify how seeds got to each location. [Eg: wind, birds, animals, other.]

- What do they look like?
- What textures do you have?
- Can you tell which plants they came from just by looking at them?
- Plant some of the seeds and see if they grow
